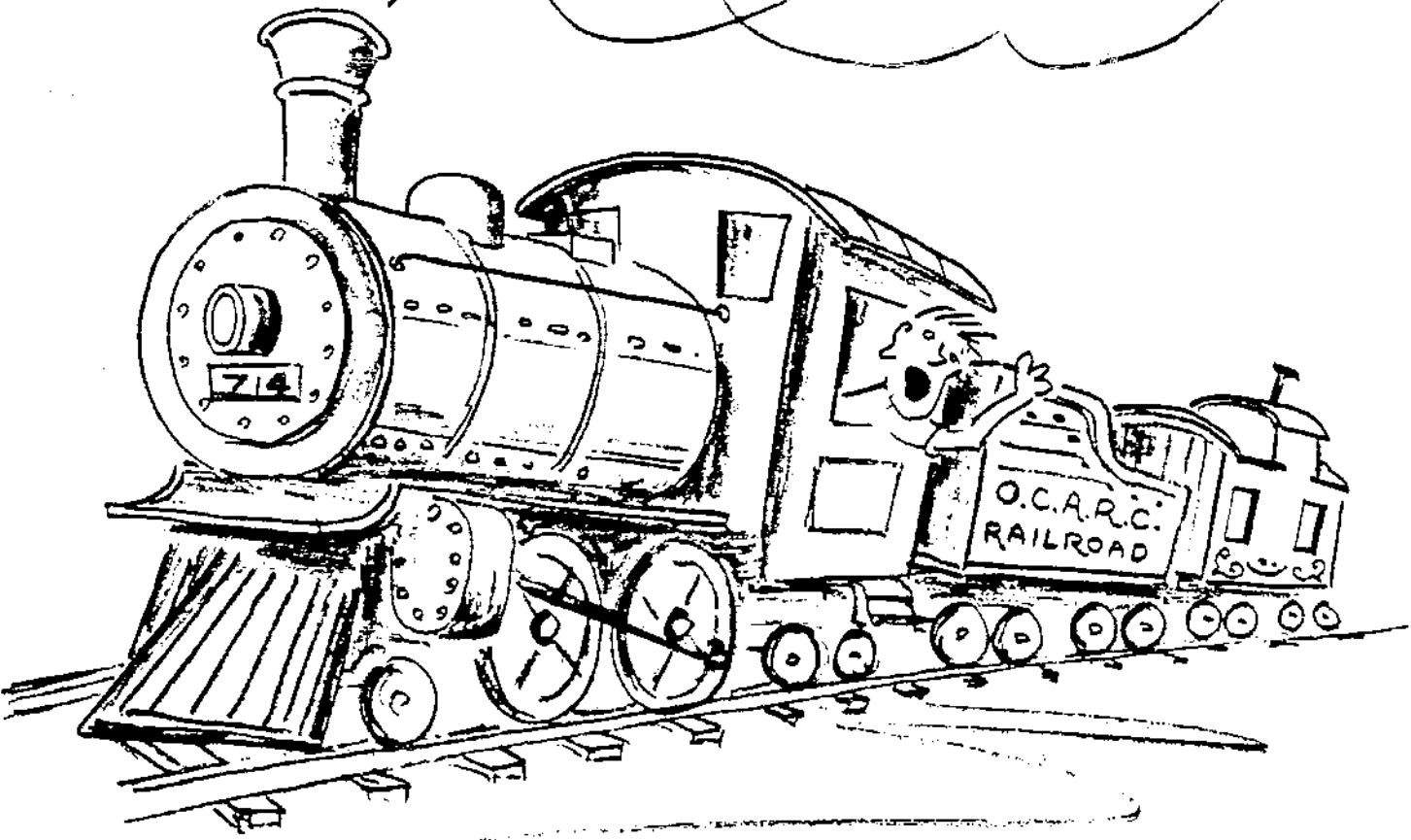

Sweden cuts top code speed

Sweden has cut its Morse code speed requirement from 12 to 5 wpm and reduced the number of license classes from four to two. The Class 1 license offers all Swedish amateur privileges and requires a 5 wpm CW test, while the Class 2 ticket is a no-code license for VHF/UHF operation only. Sweden also reportedly has a new three-year nonrenewable "study license" that offers full, and unsupervised, VHF/UHF privileges. — *W5YI Report, Newslite, ARRL Letter*
