Her passion for humanitarian work led her into the nonprofit field. In 2011, she moved from the Bay Area to Orange County to study Public Health at the University of California, Irvine. By cultivating relationships with community-based organizations and volunteers, she has been able to steward and train others to become advocates in their community.

OCARC Board of Directors Meeting Minutes August 1, 2026

Meeting held at the Streamliner Lounge, 186 Atchison Street, Orange, CA, and called to order by President, Dan KI6X, at 8:16AM. All Board members present except for Activities Director, Corey KE6YHX, and Director-at-Large, AJ W6OTO. One visitor, Bob AF6C, was present.

No reports provided by Vice-President, Secretary, Publicity, or Technical. Treasurer, Tim N6TMT, will open a second CD for the funds from the W6NGO Trust Fund, and has encountered some difficulties at the bank, which requires all three signatories to proceed and to remove Nicholas AF6CF from the current signature group. Tim will follow up with a different connection at the bank. Membership Chairman, Ron W6WG, reports current membership at 112 and discussed with Bob AF6C how to send properly the membership files for the website. Director-at-Large Dave N3BKV reports the license renewal script seems to have been a success, and currently no renewals are in process. Dave has provided via email data on usage of the remote station, including the fact that over 55% has been CW, over 80% on 20m afternoons and evenings, and most active on Saturdays.

MONTHLY PLANNER REVIEW:

State Form SI-100 needs to be filed with the State by the end of August (all even years). Treasurer, Tim N6TMT, will do so by end of this month. Auction personnel planning discussions held under New Business.

OLD BUSINESS:

Newsletter Editors: August, Tom AK6GR; September, Tim N6TMT; Dan will contact Corey KE6YHX to confirm whether he can fill the editor spot in October; November, Ron W6WG.

Entertainment: The August meeting will feature Renalynne Funtanilla of the Irvine Nature Conservancy on Firewatch. Tim N6GP will reconfirm a presentation on EME for September. October will be the annual Auction.

Storage Locker Cleanup for Auction: Ron W6WG will check in with Nicholas AF6CF regarding items stored in his local facility. A meeting to begin sorting for items for the upcoming auction will be on Saturday, August 22, at the storage locker, time to be determined.

NEW BUSINESS:

Custom Shirts: Ron W6WG suggested the club consider orange t-shirts, providing photos, with club call on the front and club name on the back as unique identifiers for club members participating in group events, and is checking into more specifics like material, sizes, and costs.

Auction Planning: Our former auctioneer Bob, AK6R, is unable to attend this year, so the event is in need of an auctioneer, multiple people to cover the financials, and someone to ferry the equipment to the front of the room and into a temporary storage area after purchase, as well as someone to oversee items get delivered to the correct purchaser. Tim N6GP, Tim N6TMT, and probably Corey KE6YHX will handle financials. Michael KO6FAR offered a laptop with a more recent Office App for ease of use since there were problems last year with the older software program. Dan KI6X, Bob AF6C, and Janet KL7MF will handle movement of the equipment. It was also suggested that the auctioneer use a microphone. Bob AF6C may have something applicable, and Tim N6GP will bring a karaoke set. Meeting temporarily paused at 8:50AM for breakfast and restarted at 9:12AM.

GOOD OF THE CLUB:

Tim N6GP proposed a committee to research a good sound set up for Zoom meetings to better sync the audio to cover the entire meeting room properly. Tim N6TMT found an example of a Zoom set up online. Dave N3BKV and Tim N6GP will work on perhaps a less expensive idea of a sound board, two sets of speakers, and an amp and report findings at the next meeting.

Bob AF6C, entertained suggestions as to replacing the center section of the webpage with something different than the Winter Field Day video that is currently showing. Any particular YouTube video, an audio clip of some sort, any number of Jean Shepherd (W9GWN) recordings: It's time to change it up.

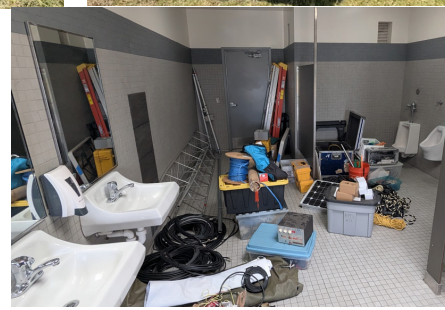
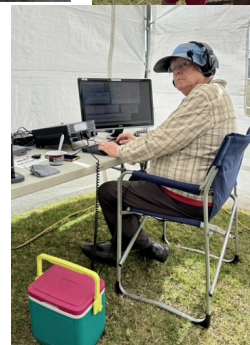
Ron W6WG, had multiple items to discuss related to Field Day: Brian KO6MMM, donated a Linux computer and other accessories, and Ron and Dave N3BKV will work together to try to perfect networking N1MM and/or N3FJP on it. N1MM is better for networking, but N3FJP is more user-friendly but has some bugs when networking. Ron W6WG, will be updating the 40m dipole structure into something more stable for FD, and will construct at least one more so there's one on the phone tower as well. Whether or not to use ladder line or coax would be determined by discussions with Bob AA6PW about available tuners. Ron W6WG, contacted the school district supervisor about using one of the portable units the school has at the FD site for storage of the club's FD equipment. The supervisor suggested a 20 ft container at the district administration offices for about \$1 a year might be possible. Ron provided club information to help sweeten the pot. Ron W6WG, also suggested since we are using only 30 ft each of the club's two towers that we consider getting gone more 14 ft straight section of the aluminum Universal model #4-50, giving us three 30 ft towers instead of two. Janet KL7MF, will check local tower/ antenna service people and other sources for availability. Ron W6WG, also suggested the club consider keeping some of the equipment that gets donated to us from estates for use at Field Day rather than move it all at the auction or put up for sale at a club meeting.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:35AM.

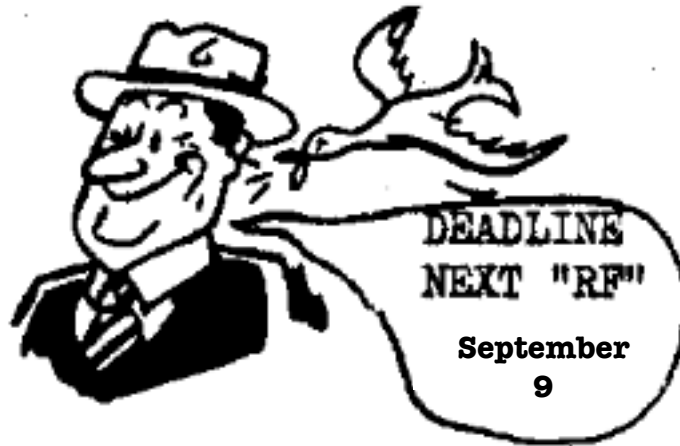
