He will be operating from Glorioso Islands some time the week of August 10, 1970.

The Manahiki Operation is to be operational the end of August. Check the Pacific DX Net for information on Monday and Thursday nights at 0600 GMT (really Tuesday and Friday morning!) on 14265. Also, listen for K3RLY and PY2PE on 14220 at around 2200 to 0100 GMT.

The latter group has formed the International DX Association. The sole purpose of this organization is to help rare DX Stations become more active and to support DXpeditions. This being accomplished by donation of equipment to these stations.
