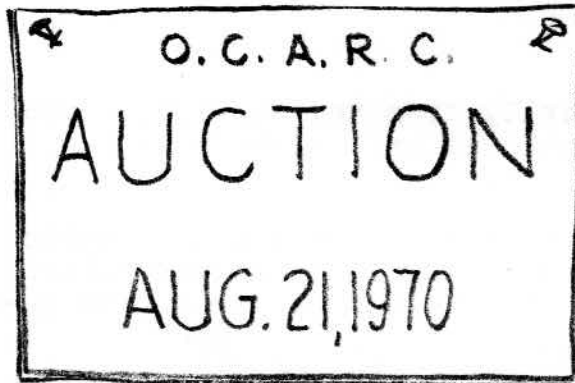

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

Ken - W6HHC, Chairman of the Orange County Council of Amateur Radio Organizations, reported on the O.C.C.A.R.O. Meeting held on July 14th. Members of the O.C.A.R.C., N.A.R.S., A.A.R.C., and F.A.R.C. were at the meeting in addition to John Griggs - W6KW (Director, Southwestern Division) and Jerry VerDuft - WA6ROF (SCM, Orange Section). The 1971 Convention progress and the outcome of the W6ZQZ Antenna hearing was reported. Ken also reported on the rise in license fees.

John - W6BNX, reported that the Treasury now held \$ 800.55, and that we had 46 paid members this year as compared to 51 members at the same time last year. Jerry VerDuft - WA6ROF, showed a film he had taken at the Field Day sites of various Orange County Clubs.
