BICENTENNIAL CALLSIGNS (via HR REPORT)

BICENTENNIAL CALLSIGN SCHEME has been released, and as expected all FCC-licensed amateurs can have some fun with it in 1976 if they're so inclined. Stateside alternate prefixes are straight forward, with WA becoming AA, W changing to AC, and even repeaters getting an optional AF.

Outside The Contiguous U.S. is where the fun really begins, however, with Samoa becoming AH3 and an Alaskan Novice an AL1.

The Complete Scheme appears in chart form on page 3 of this issue. Don't rush to cut it out since we'll include a larger scale chart as a separate sheet sometime late this year.

Use Of The Alternate Prefixes is entirely optional and no paperwork will be required. Just remember they don't go into effect until 0500Z January 1, 1976 and are good until January 1, 1977.
