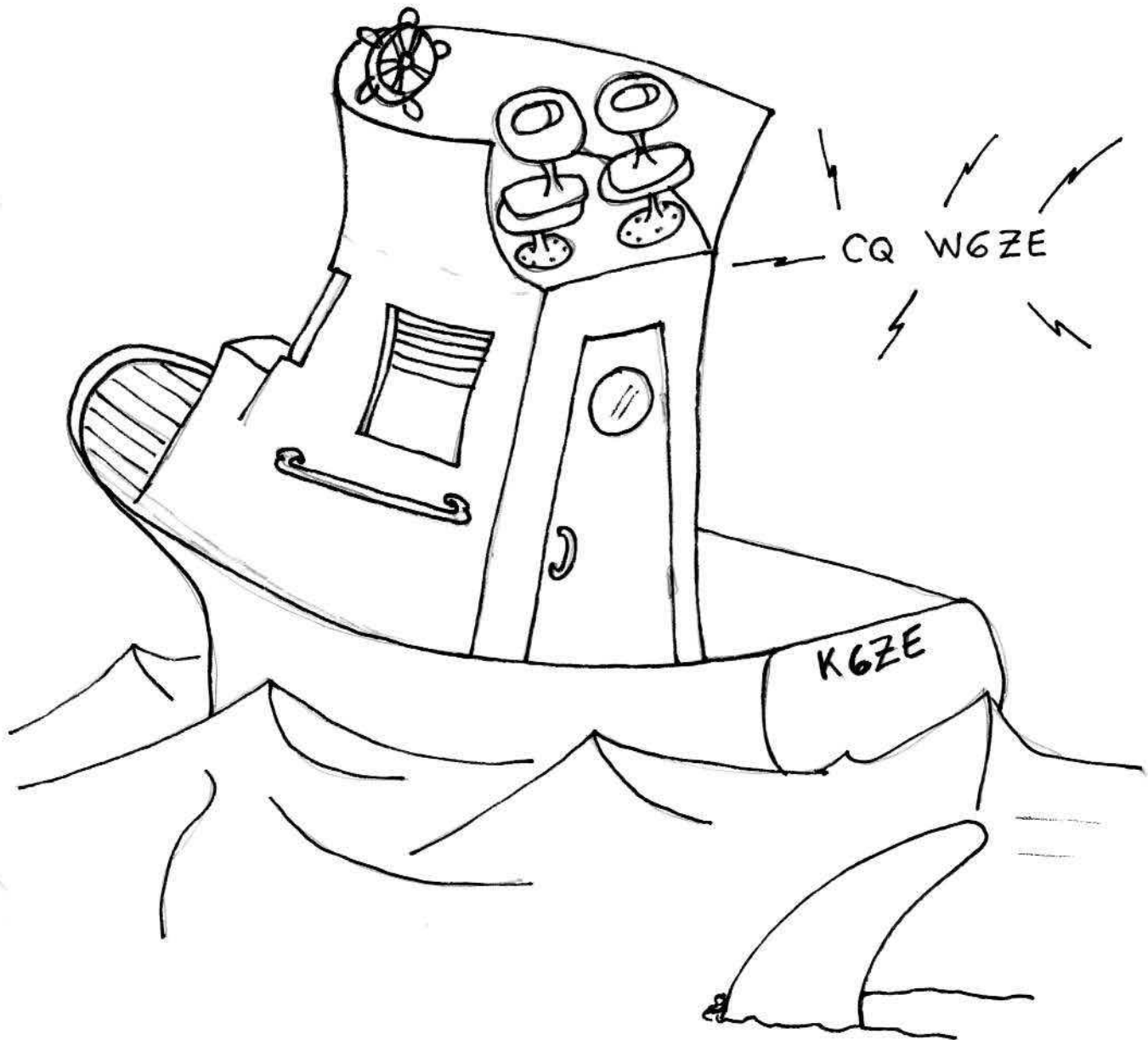

TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS

WE REGRET TO ANNOUNCE THAT DESPITE EFFORTS OF ARRL THROUGH THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT THE GOVERNMENT OF ROUMANIA HAS DECLINED TO GRANT A TEMPORARY THIRD PARTY TRAFFIC AGREEMENT FOR THE HANDLING OF PERSONAL WELFARE INQUIRIES BY AMATEUR RADIO. CONSEQUENTLY, THE HANDLING OF SUCH COMMUNICATIONS THIS TIME IS CONTRARY TO INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS LAW TO WHICH THE U.S. IS SIGNATORY.

THE CHART INDICATES THAT THERE ARE NO MORE AVAILABLE K OR W PREFIXES IN THE 4TH CALL AREA AND NO W PREFIXES LEFT IN THE 6TH CALL AREA. THE CHART MAY BE OBTAINED BY SENDING A SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE WITH 24 CENTS POSTAGE ADDRESSED TO CALL SIGNS, ARRL, 225 MAIN ST., NEWINGTON, CT. 06111.

HR OFFICIAL BULLETIN NR 638 FROM ARRL HEADQUARTERS
NEWINGTON CT MARCH 24, 1977
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY THE FCC HAS CANCELLED ITS PROGRAM OF MAILING NOVICE EXAMINATIONS IN BULK TO QUALIFIED EXAMINERS. THE FCC CLAIMS THAT THE PROGRAM HAS PROVEN UNSATISFACTORY AND HAS IMPOSED ADDED BURDENS ON THE STAFF AT GETTYSBURG, PA.

FCC STATES THAT MANY EXAMS ARE SIMPLY NOT BEING RETURNED AND MANY EXAMINERS APPEAR TO BE REQUESTING MULTIPLE TESTS JUST TO HAVE THEM ON HAND IN CASE OF FUTURE NEED. VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS MUST NOW FIRST CONDUCT THE NOVICE CODE TEST, AND THEN MAIL AN APPLICATION PRIOR TO ADMINISTERING EACH NOVICE WRITTEN EXAM, AS PREVIOUSLY REQUIRED.

NEWINGTON CT APRIL 5, 1977
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS

SEVERE FLOODING HAS CAUSED A COMMUNICATIONS EMERGENCY IN PORTIONS OF SOUTHWESTERN VIRGINIA AND SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA. AN EMERGENCY NET HAS BEEN ACTIVATED ON 3990 KHZ BY THE WEST VIRGINIA CIVIL DEFENSE AND THE VIRGINIA FONE NET IS OPERATING CONTINUOUSLY ON 3947 KHZ. AMATEURS HAVE ALSO SUPPLIED EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS IN THE WAKE OF TORNADOES IN ALABAMA, MISSISSIPPI AND MICHIGAN.

HR PROPAGATION FORECAST BULLETIN NR 30 FROM ARRL HEADQUARTERS
NEWINGTON CT APRIL 4, 1977
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS

THE LOW SOLAR ACTIVITY SHOWED SIGNS OF CHANGE AS WE MOVED INTO APRIL. THE SOLAR FLUX ROSE FROM 74 ON MARCH 31 TO 77 ON APRIL 3, AND IS EXPECTED TO GO SOMEWHAT HIGHER IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. GEOMAGNETIC ACTIVITY IS RISING ALSO, AND PROPAGATION IS BELOW NORMAL FOR THE SEASON AS THIS BULLETIN IS BEING PREPARED.

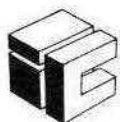
VISIBLE ACTIVITY ON THE SUN HAS BEEN CONFINED TO VERY SMALL SPOTS AND MINOR FLARES PROVIDING LITTLE BASIS FOR ANTICIPATING CHANGES RELATED TO THE FOUR WEEK ROTATIONAL PERIOD OF THE SUN. BRIGHT EAST LIMB ACTIVITY SEEN IN RECENT DAYS WILL BE MOVING INTO POSITION TO AFFECT PROPAGATION LATER THIS WEEK, IF IT LASTS THAT LONG. GENERALLY UNSETTLED CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED THROUGH APRIL 7 AND INTERMITTENTLY THEREAFTER THROUGH THE 12TH.

EXAMINATION OF PROPAGATION CHARTS IN APRIL QST WILL SHOW MOST PATHS IN BETWEEN THE CONDITIONS FOR FEBRUARY AND MARCH, WITH ONLY TRANSEQUATORIAL CIRCUITS SHOWING IMPROVEMENT OVER ANY RECENT PERIOD. THE INCIDENCE OF SPORADIC E SKIP WILL INCREASE WITH THE ADVANCE OF SPRING. THIS AND GENERALLY HIGHER ATMOSPHERIC NOISE WILL LIMIT THE RANGE OF LOWER FREQUENCIES, BUT SPORADIC E WILL PROVIDE INTERESTING OPENINGS ON 21 AND 28 MHZ, MOST COMMONLY IN MIDMORNING AND EARLY EVENING HOURS.
