

ARRL OFFICIALS MEETING

Len Bleier from the Department of Motor Vehicles, Sacramento, was the guest speaker and on the "hot seat" at the ARRL Southwest Division Officials meeting June 18th at the Caravan Inn in Riverside. The meeting was attended by 50+ amateurs from the Southwestern Division.

Mr. Bleier assured those attending that Senate Bill No. 915 as it is written will be changed before it is resubmitted to the Senate for a vote. It will not have the reoccuring vanity plate fee, but will reflect the cost of the special processing (actually making the plates plus the paper work involved by the DMV) which will be approximately \$16.00 if the figures the DMV now have are valid. Those now holding Ham plates will not have additional charges since this cost is for the processing of new plates. Since one of the points the DMV has made, and which could make an impact on the Senate Transportation Committee, is that only 33% of the Amateurs licensed in the State now have Amateur Call License Plates, the implication is to urge all Hams in the State of California TO GET YOUR AMATEUR CALL LICENSE PLATES NOW not only because it will cost more to obtain these plates in the next year or two, but also to make an impression on the DMV and the Senate that AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS DO CARE AND ARE PROUD OF THEIR HOBBY! Mr. Bleier answered questions from those present until time ran out for that part of the meeting. 
