THE ANNUAL AUCTION MEETING OF THE ORANGE COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB WILL BE HELD ON FRIDAY EVENING SEPTEMBER 18, 1981 AT 7:00 P. M. IN THE COMMUNITY ROOM OF MERCURY SAVINGS AND LOAN 1095 IRVINE BLVD. IN THE CITY OF TUSTIN, CALIFORNIA.

AUCTION RULES

SELLERS

EQUIPMENT ENTERED IN THE OCARC AUCTION SHALL BE LIMITED TO QUALITY RADIO AND ELECTRONICS EQUIPMENT AN EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE IS THAT PARTS OF DUBIOUS QUALITY SHALL BE PACKAGED SO THAT THE MINIMUM BID SHALL BE ONE DOLLAR OR MORE.

ALL MERCHANDISE SHALL BE TAGGED PRIOR TO 6:45 P. M. , OCARC SHALL SUPPLY THE TAGS STARTING AT 5:45 P. M.

THERE SHALL BE AN INITIAL LIMIT OF TEN TAGS PER SELLER.

TEN PERCENT OF THE SELLING PRICE FOR EACH TAG WILL BE PAID TO OCARC WITH A MAXIMUM OF EIGHT DOLLARS FOR EACH TAGGED ITEM GOING TO OCARC.

A MINIMUM BID MAY BE PLACED ON AN ITEM. IF THE ITEM DOES NOT SELL, A COMMISSION OF FIVE PERCENT OF THE MINIMUM BID TO A MAXIMUM OF FIVE DOLLARS PER TAGGED ITEM SHALL BE PAID TO OCARC.

SELLERS REGISTRATION FEE SHALL BE TWO DOLLARS PLUS FIVE PERCENT OF THE MINIMUM BID ITEMS TO A MAXIMUM OF FIVE DOLLARS PER BID ITEM.

ALL SELLERS WILL BE PAID BY THE CLUB TREASURER AFTER THE AUCTION AND ALL PURCHASES ARE COMPLETED.
