RADIO OPERATOR EXAMINATIONS - 1984

PRIOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION REQUIRED

The following information describes the Commercial and Amateur examinations given by the Long Beach District Office. The tests will not be given at the FCC office but at a rented facility. After submission of the proper form, you will receive a notification card with the time, date and place to appear. You must bring this card to the exam point. Further information should be obtained from this office by writing to the above address or calling (213) 426-4451.

COMMERCIAL OPERATOR EXAMINATIONS (General Radiotelephone, Marine Permit, Radar Endorsement, Telegraph)

- 1. Obtain FCC Form 756 from this office.
- 2. Submit FCC Form 756 to this office with current operator license, if held, by the DEADLINE date shown below.

AMATEUR OPERATOR EXAMINATIONS (All classes except Novice)

- 1. Obtain FCC Form 610 (August 1980 or later).
- 2. Submit FCC Form 610 to this office with current amateur license, interim permit, code credit certificates, if held, by the DEADLINE date shown below.

As most of you know, I am the token U.S. Marine in the club, and contrary to some opinions, I am at least semi-literate.


Editorial comment is one of the few privileges of this job and from time to time I will voice my opinions on the current amateur radio issues of the day.
