Our contest features awards along with the possibility of national and international recognition for you.

The ARRL is sponsoring a national art contest with the theme "Youth in Amateur Radio." It is a wide-open theme, which allows you to use your imagination in the following mediums: photographs, drawings, paintings and other illustrations (excluding written text). - All entries must be received at ARRL HQ no later than February 1, 1987.
- Entrants must be League members or be sponsored by a League member. (If you don't know any members, write to ARRL for a list of possible sponsors.)
- Each entry must be accompanied by a completed application form (available from ARRL).
- Each entry must be the original creation of the entrant.
- Entries become the property of ARRL, and cannot be returned.
- Artwork must be no larger than
 11 x 14 inches.
