

HAM OPERATORS NEEDED FOR CARRIAGE EVENT -SUNDAY OCT 15

It's time again for me to ask for volunteers to participate in one of my other hobbies - carriage driving. My carriage club, the Heels and Wheels, is putting on a combined driving event in Pomona this year on October 14, 15 and 16. The main event that I need operators is Sunday October 15. This will be the day of the marathon.

This year it will be held at Bonelli Park, located just behind the Fair area in Pomona. Access is off Via Verde off the 210 FWY. Last year there were about 25 horse drawn carriages in the event. The longest course is about 12 KM and involves cross country driving and negotiating some natural and man made hazards. These hazards are timed and penalties are assessed for knock downs, etc. This information will be relayed to the scoring van so that it can be entered on the computer for up-to-date scores. The primary mission of the operators, however, will be safety. In case of a break down or injury, we will need to know so that we can get help in the way of a truck or horse trailer.

Everyone who has worked this event so far has been quite enthusiastic about it. If you are interested please give me a call (714 - 531 0926) so I can firm up my list by October.
